ENERGY COMMISSION IN ARUSHA TO REVIEW THE FINAL STAGES OF
CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF MODERN EQUIPMENT IN THE NEW
MEGA COMPLEX LABORATORY**

Arusha, 10 May, 2018

Honorable Minister of Education Science and Technology Prof. Joyce Ndalichako (MP) paid a visit to the Tanzania Atomic Energy Commission Headquarters in Arusha to review the final stages of construction and installation of modern equipment in the new laboratory. The lab facility will be used for calibrating and testing radiation equipment in order to increase the safety and control of radioactive sources in the country.

The new mega complex laboratory is being constructed by the Government for a total amount of 2.38 billion Tshs and will have modern-sponsored equipment by the European Union with a value total of Tshs 11 billion. This state of art equipments will serve needs not only within the country but also all other countries in the East African Region and beyond.

When addressing TAEC Staff Hon. Minister advised the staff to cooperate and work hard, while emphasizing that the Government has invested a very large amount of money on laboratory construction, so the staff must use the laboratory to deliver quality services effectively and boost productivity for the nation and the country in general.
